APPLICATION for PERMIT FOR THE RETAIL SALE OF FIREWORKS IN PERMANENT AND TEMPORARY STRUCTURES

Any sale of legal fireworks in the City of La Crosse shall require a permit to do so. "Fireworks" is defined as any combustible or explosive composition, substance or combination of substances, or any article prepared for the purpose of producing a visible or audible effect by combustion, explosion, deflagration or detonation.

General Requirements of Local AHJ:

1. The provisions of Section 167.10 of the Wisconsin Statutes and any amendments thereto relating to the regulations of fireworks are hereby adopted by reference.
2. Any person or business that sells fireworks must comply with all local building and fire codes, state statutes and NFPA 1124 and NFPA 101.
3. All persons requesting a seller's permit shall include with the permit application an annual fee as referenced in Appendix C – Fee Schedule of the La Crosse Municipal Code.
4. A certificate of insurance for a minimum of \$200,000 for each claim or \$500,000 for each incident shall be included with application.
5. The local AHJ reserves the right to perform a compliance inspection at any time.
6. The local AHJ reserves the right to request a sample product for testing.
7. Fee for Permit is \$300.00 per location.
