In the News:

March 5th, the La Crosse Fire Department responds to needle pick-up calls but reminded the public of nine drop box locations throughout the area as well as four other locations, which take larger amounts of disposals.

March 6th, Community Risk Management reminded the public to not dispose of lithium batteries in the trash; rather take them to the La Crosse County Solid Waste Services.

March 13th, Fire officials requested the public to hold off on water recreation until the water temperature goes up. Hypothermia can occur in any water temperature below 70°F, which is well above any water temperatures around the City of La Crosse.

March 25th, the La Crosse Fire Department responded to the 1000 block of Rose Street for a stone fire at a two-story single-family home.

March 27th, the La Crosse Fire Department extinguished a fire just before 1:00 a.m. Friday at the Xcel Energy French Island Generating Station. The fire was contained to the machine and no one was injured.



Here is an example of one of our posts:

DO NOT MIX THESE CLEANING PRODUCTS

BLEACH + VINEGAR

Bleach and vinegar mixture produces chlorine gas, which can cause coughing, breathing problems, burning and watery eyes.



Bleach and ammonia produce a toxic gas called chloramine. It causes shortness of breath and chest pain.


BLEACH + RUBBING ALCOHOL

Bleach and rubbing alcohol makes chloroform, which is highly toxic.

HYDROGEN PEROXIDE + VINEGAR

This combination makes peracetic/peroxyacetic acid, which can be highly corrosive


