Notable Incidents:

- February 9th, LCFD responded to an apartment fire at 136
 Milwaukee Street at 8:19 pm. Crews arrived with three minutes and quickly extinguished the fire, which had expanded to the second floor. All residents were evacuated safely with no injuries reported. This incident is still under investigation.
- February 14th, LCFD responded to a structure fire at 725
 Cameron Ave at 4:30 am. Crews arrived within four minutes and were able to contain the fire to one single unit. The occupant was found deceased in the unit and this incident is still under investigation.
- February 18th, LCFD responded to a structure fire 814 Kane Street at 4:47 am. Crews arrived within four minutes to extinguish the exterior fire prior to expanding to the interior. The occupants were evacuated safely and no injuries were reported. This incident is also still under investigation.
