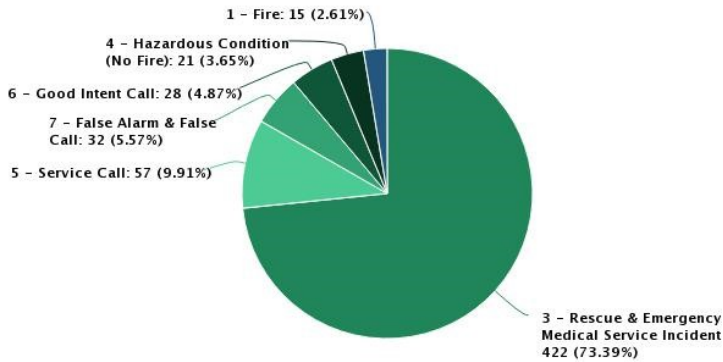

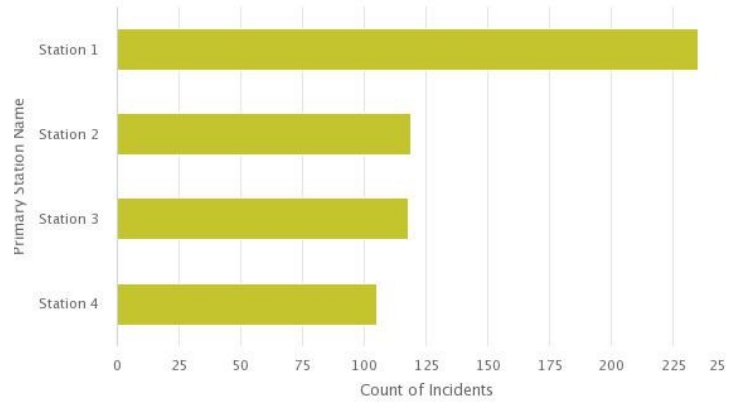
#### Incident Type Categories

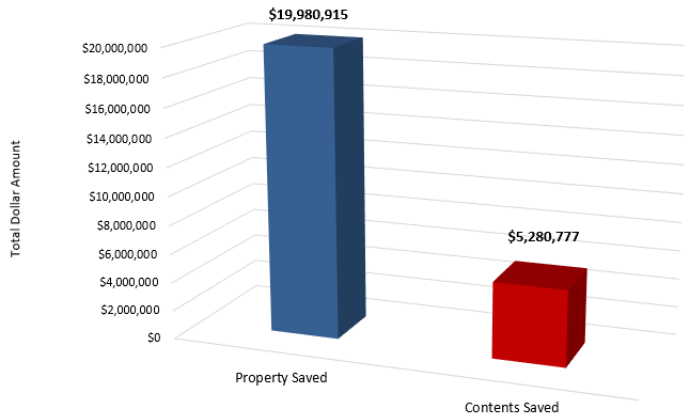
#### Incidents by Primary Station Name

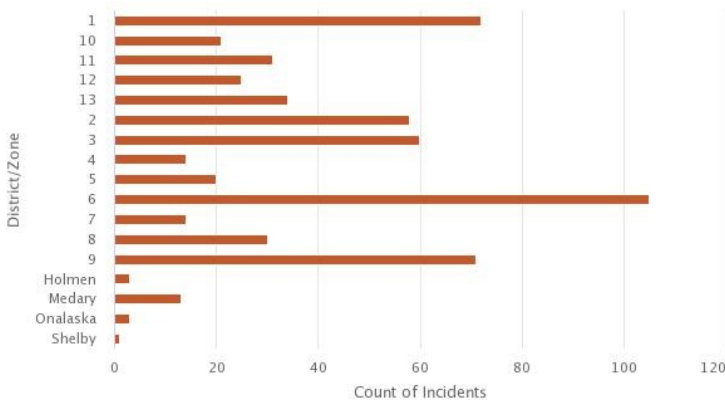
#### Incidents by Month

May 01, 2021 to Apr 30, 2022



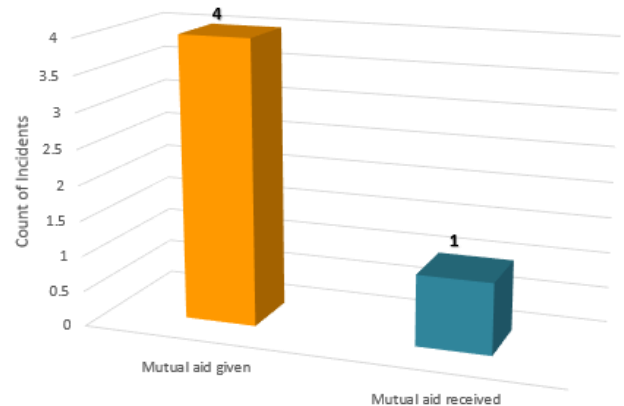
#### Incidents by District/Zone

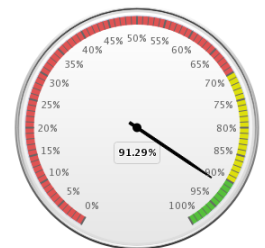

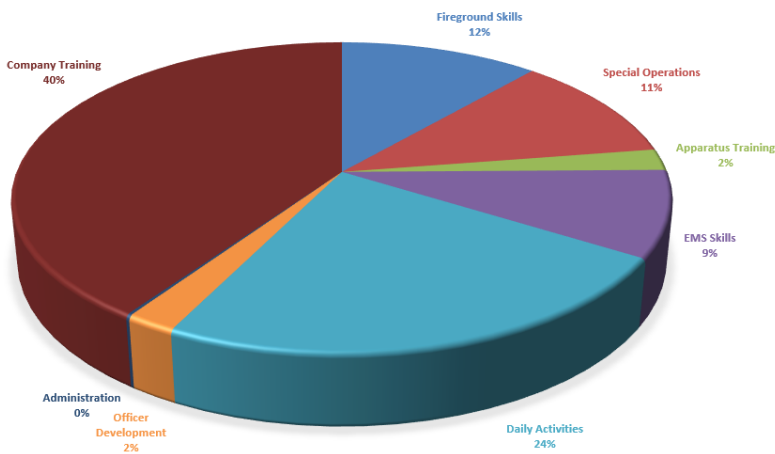

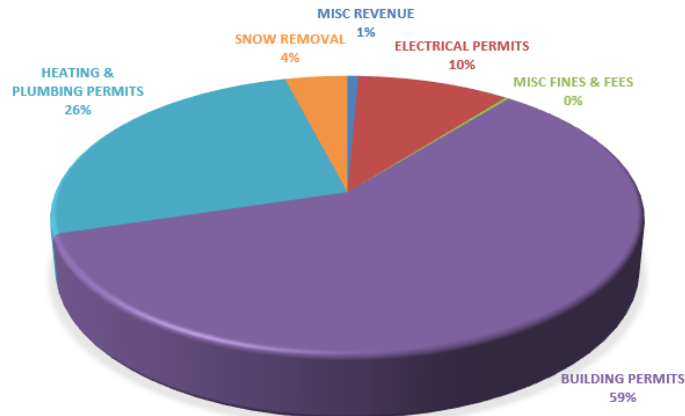
