APPLICATION FOR THE RETAIL SALE OF FIREWORKS IN PERMANENT OR TEMPORARY STRUCTURES

Any sale of legal fireworks in the City of La Crosse shall require a permit to do so. "Fireworks" is defined as any combustible or explosive composition, substance or combination of substances, or any article prepared for the purpose of producing a visible or audible effect by combustion, explosion, deflagration or detonation.

General Requirements of Local AHJ:

- 1) The provisions of Section 167.10 of the Wisconsin Statutes and any amendments thereto relating to the regulations of fireworks are hereby adopted by reference.
- 2) Any person or business that sells fireworks must comply with all local building and fire codes, state statutes and NFPA 1124 and NFPA 101.
- 3) All persons requesting a seller's permit shall include with the permit application an annual fee as reference in Appendix C Fee Schedule of the La Crosse Municipal Code.
- 4) A certificate of insurance for minimum of \$200,000 for each claim or \$500,000 for each incident shall be included within application.
- 5) The local AHJ reserves the right to perform a compliance inspection at any time.
- 6) The local AHJ reserves the right to request a sample product for testing.
- 7) Fee for permit is \$300.00 per location.
