Department Highlights:

- Brett Holden began his employment September 5th

Notable Incidents:

- September 1st, LCFD responded to Grandad's Bluff for an injured bicyclist. Due to the terrain, the department's UTV was utilized and the patient was successfully transferred into Tri-State Ambulance's care. Crews had the patient stabilized with 25 minutes of being dispatched.
- September 4th, LCFD responded to a structure fire at 1906 Rose Street at 4:26pm. Crews arrived within three minutes to find smoke and fire coming from an entrance under a wooden awning. The fire was extinguished quickly and it was contained to the exterior of the building. The cause of the fire was the improper discarding of smoking materials.






